YANG V. MUEHLBAUER

The Court has entered the following order:

On March 17, 2026, pro se petitioner Kay Xiong Yang, et al., filed a petition for writ of quo warranto.

The petition was improperly signed, as it appears that petitioner Kay Xiong Yang's signature was inserted electronically. Pursuant to WIS. STAT. §§ (Rule) 802.05(1) and 809.80(1), all filings by a person who is not an electronic filer must be physically signed by the party. The party may then file either the original paper document bearing the wet-ink signature of the party or a photocopy of the original paper document that bears the party's original signature. Inserting an electronic copy of an individual's signature into an electronic document and then filing a printed paper copy of the electronic document is not permitted.

Additionally, all signers are required to include their address and telephone number. *See* WIS. STAT. § 802.05. The petitioners in this matter did not include their addresses or telephone numbers. The only signer to include her address was Kay Xiong Yang, and her address is incorrect, as the court is aware that petitioner Kay Xiong Yang is currently in custody at the Taycheedah Correctional Institution. Therefore, all correspondence and documents related to this matter will be sent to Kay Xiong Yang solely at Taycheedah Correctional Institution, her address on record with the court. This is consistent with the court's standard practice to send notices and orders solely to a pro se litigant at the litigant's current address on record. As the other petitioners did not provide a proper current address, their copies of this order will be sent to the Thiensville, Wisconsin, address listed in the petition.

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Despite these deficiencies in the filing, the court has considered the petition for writ of quo warranto on its merits. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that the petition for writ is denied, ex parte.

Please be advised that any future pro se paper submission containing an electronically inserted signature will not be accepted for filing. Be further advised that any future pro se paper submission that does not include correct current addresses and telephone numbers for all signers will also not be accepted for filing.
