The Court has entered the following order:

The Office of Lawyer Regulation (OLR) filed a motion, along with a supporting affidavit and exhibits, seeking the summary suspension of Attorney Robert Lee Taylor's license to practice law in Wisconsin pursuant to SCR 22.20. The motion is based upon Attorney Taylor's conviction of three counts of second-degree sexual assault, one count of misdemeanor battery, and one count of strangulation and suffocation. *State v. Taylor*, Milwaukee County Case No. 2022CF4881.

On June 22, 2026, this court issued an order directing Attorney Taylor to show cause, in writing, by July 13, 2026, why the OLR's motion for summary suspension should not be granted. Attorney Taylor has not filed a response to this order. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that the motion is granted. The license of Attorney Robert Lee Taylor to practice law in this state is temporarily suspended as of the date of this order and until further notice of this court. He shall further comply with the requirements of SCR 22.26 relating to license suspension if he has not already done so.
