The Court, by its Commissioners, has entered the following order:

On August 25, 2026, this court received a motion, filed by defendant-appellant, Michael Mario Miller, Jr., pro se, for reconsideration of the court's August 12, 2026 order dismissing his petition to bypass the court of appeals as untimely. That same day, Mr. Miller also filed a "Motion to Supplement Petitioner Motion to bypass the court of appeals, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.60." Under WIS. STAT. § (Rule) 809.60(1)(a), a petition to bypass the court of appeals must be filed "no later than 14 days after the filing of the respondent's brief." As Mr. Miller acknowledges, the respondent's brief was filed in the court of appeals on July 17, 2026, making any petition to bypass due by July 31, 2026. Mr. Miller signed his petition on August 6, 2026, making his filing untimely. Upon the foregoing,

IT IS ORDERED that the motion for reconsideration is denied; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the court will take no action on the "Motion to Supplement Petitioner Motion to bypass the court of appeals, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.60."
