The Court has entered the following order:

The Office of Lawyer Regulation (OLR) filed a motion, along with a supporting affidavit and exhibits, seeking the summary suspension of Attorney Michael D. Huitink's license to practice law in Wisconsin pursuant to SCR 22.20. The motion is based on Attorney Huitink's conviction, following his no contest plea, to one felony count of operating a vehicle while intoxicated, causing injury, as a second and subsequent offense. *See State v. Huitink*, Waukesha County Case No. 2025CF1155.

On July 23, 2026, this court issued an order directing Attorney Huitink to show cause, in writing, by August 12, 2026, why the OLR's motion for summary suspension should not be granted. Attorney Huitink has not filed a response to this order. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that the motion is granted. The license of Attorney Michael D. Huitink to practice law in this state is temporarily suspended as of the date of this order and until further notice of this court. He shall further comply with the requirements of SCR 22.26 relating to license suspension if he has not already done so.
