On July 9, 2020, defendant-appellant-petitioner, Duanne D. Townsend, through counsel, filed a motion entitled "Motion for Leave to File a Nonconforming Petition for Review and Supplemental Memorandum." Mr. Townsend requests this court accept the motion as a timely but non-conforming petition for review of the court of appeals' decision of June 9, 2020, and further requests 30 days to file either a supplemental memorandum in support of the petition or a motion to dismiss the petition.
