Patterson v. Kohn L.C. #2016CV6408

By order dated February 28, 2020, this court granted the motion of plaintiff-appellant-petitioner, Brian A. Patterson, pro se, and deemed the motion to be a timely but nonconforming petition for review. The February 28, 2020 order directed Mr. Patterson to file a supplemental statement in support of the petition, conforming to the requirements of Wis. Stat. §§ 809.62(2) and (4), by April 13, 2020. On April 15, 2020, Mr. Patterson filed a motion for an extension of time to file his statement in support of the petition for review. By order dated May 28, 2020, this court granted the motion for an extension of time and directed Mr. Patterson (1) to file a statement in support of the petition for review conforming with the requirements of Wis. Stat. §§ 809.62(2) and (4) by July 3, 2020, and (2) to pay the filing fee or to file an affidavit of indigency by July 3, 2020.

The May 28, 2020 order advised Mr. Patterson that if the statement in support of the petition and the affidavit of indigency were not filed by July 3, 2020, the petition for review would be summarily dismissed.

On July 23, 2020, defendants-respondents, Steven R. Kohn, et al., filed a motion to dismiss the petition for review, noting that they had received no statement in support from Mr. Patterson.

The court has not received any statement in support of the petition for review, nor has it received the filing fee for the petition or an affidavit of indigency. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED the motion to dismiss is granted, and the petition for review is summarily dismissed for failure to comply with the court's May 28, 2020 order. No costs.
