On July 17, 2020, defendant-appellant, Jorell Martrell Luckett, pro se, filed a motion to extend the time in which to file a petition to review the court of appeals' decision of June 16, 2020, which the court of appeals declined to reconsider by order of July 8, 2020. This court denied the motion but construed it as a timely but nonconforming petition for review, and gave Mr. Luckett until August 20, 2020, to file a statement in support of the petition that conformed to the requirements of Wis. Stat. §§ 809.62(2) and (4). On August 7, 2020, Mr. Luckett filed a letter that this court has construed as a motion for the appointment of counsel to prepare the statement in support of his nonconforming petition for review, and for an extension of time to file this statement.

IT IS ORDERED that the motion for appointment of counsel is denied. There is no right to appointed counsel on petitions for review where a no-merit report was filed in the court of appeals and where the court of appeals (1) has determined that further appellate proceedings would be frivolous and without arguable merit, (2) has affirmed the judgment of conviction or final adjudication and the denial of any postconviction or postdisposition motion, and (3) has therefore relieved appellate counsel of any further responsibility in the case. Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.32(3).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the motion for extension of time to file the statement in support of the nonconforming petition for review is granted. Mr. Lockett's statement in support of the petition shall be filed on or before September 11, 2020. If the statement is not filed by that time, this petition will be summarily dismissed. No further extensions will be granted.
