State v. Thames L.C.#s 2010CF4751 and 2010CF6162

By order dated June 17, 2020, this court construed the "Motion to Clarify Procedure" filed by defendant-appellant, De-Yul Thames, pro se, as a timely but nonconforming petition to review the court of appeals decision of March 4, 2020, which the court of appeals declined to reconsider by order of May 26, 2020. This court gave Mr. Thames until July 17, 2020 to file a statement in support of the petition that conformed to the requirements of Wis. Stat. §§ 809.62(2) and (4). By order dated July 3, 2020, this court ordered Mr. Thames to submit a written statement clarifying the relief sought in Mr. Thames' "Motion to File Enlarged Documents" filed on June 26, 2020. On August 7, 2020, Mr. Thames filed a statement advising the court that his June 26, 2020 motion should be construed as a motion to exceed the 35-page limit for a statement in support of his nonconforming petition for review. Mr. Thames also filed a motion for enlargement of time to file a statement in support of his nonconforming petition for review. Accordingly,
