The court having considered the second motion of defendant-appellant, Jason J. Hyatt, pro se, for relief and the appointment of counsel to assist in his filing of a petition for review of the court of appeals' decision of June 25, 2020;

IT IS ORDERED that the motion is denied. There is no right to appointed counsel on petitions for review where a no-merit report was filed in the court of appeals and where the court of appeals (1) has determined that further appellate proceedings would be frivolous and without arguable merit, (2) has affirmed the judgment of conviction or final adjudication and the denial of any postconviction or postdisposition motion, and (3) has therefore relieved appellate counsel of any further responsibility in the case.
