Suri v. Jaeger L.C. #2010CF1012

The court has before it a "Petition For Writ Of Habeas Corpus" and a "Motion For Injunctive Relief Due To New Contributing COVID And Prison Conditions," both of which are signed by Daniel Hawk on behalf of Deke Suri, whom the filings identify as a prisoner at the Prairie du Chien Correctional Institution. Mr. Hawk is not a licensed attorney in Wisconsin. Mr. Suri did not sign either filing.

IT IS ORDERED that the habeas petition and accompanying motion for injunctive relief are dismissed. Although Mr. Suri may represent himself in this court, he may not be represented by a non-attorney such as Mr. Hawk. See Wis. Stat. § 757.30; see also *Jadair, Inc. v. United States Fire Ins. Co.*, 209 Wis.2d 187, 562 N.W.2d 401 (1997). Under § 802.05(1), a party who is not
