No. 2020AP1739-W      Suri v. Jaeger L.C. #2010CF1012

Mr. Deke Suri, pro se, has filed: (1) a petition for writ of habeas corpus seeking to challenge the Outagamie County Circuit Court's denial of Mr. Suri's motion for modification of his sentence in State v. Suri, Outagamie County Case No. 10CF1012, by orders of September 18 and October 8, 2020; and (2) a "Petition For Rehearing," which challenges this court's November 18, 2020 dismissal of a similar habeas petition and accompanying motion signed only by a non-attorney, Daniel Hawk, on behalf of Mr. Suri.

"Habeas corpus is not a substitute for appeal and therefore, a writ will not be issued where the 'petitioner has an otherwise adequate remedy that he or she may exercise to obtain the same relief.'" State v. Pozo, 2002 WI App 279, ¶8, 258 Wis. 2d 796, 654 N.W.2d 12 (citation omitted).
