addresses the issues raised in the Legislature's response by 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, February 9, 2021. The court concludes that it would be appropriate for the Petitioners, Tony Evers, in his official capacity as Governor, and Joel Brennan, in his official capacity of Secretary of Department of Administration, to file a reply memorandum to the Response to Petition for Original Action by that same date and time. In the interest of conserving resources, Petitioners Evers and Brennan may incorporate by reference the arguments filed in the combined response and reply referenced above. Any document filed in compliance with this mandate shall be filed as an attachment in pdf format to an email addressed to clerk@wicourts.gov. See Wis. Stat. §§ 809.14, 809.80, and 809.81. The filing party shall also ensure a paper original and 10 copies of the filing are received by the clerk within 24 hours of the electronic filing with the following notation on the top of the first page: "This document was previously filed via email."
