No. 2020AP920-CR State v. Jacques L.C.# 2007CF734

On December 7, 2020, John L. Jacques, pro se, filed a petition to bypass the court of appeals. Wisconsin Stat. § (Rule) 809.60(1) states that “[a] party may file with the supreme court a petition to bypass the court of appeals pursuant to s. 808.05 no later than 14 days following the filing of the respondent’s brief under s. 809.19 or response.” The State of Wisconsin filed its response brief in the court of appeals on September 24, 2020, making any bypass petition due 14 days thereafter; i.e., by October 8, 2020. Mr. Jacques filed his bypass petition many weeks beyond this date. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that the petition to bypass is dismissed as untimely.
