Casteel v. Circuit Court for Grant County L.C. #2011IP3

On March 6, 2012, petitioner-petitioner, John Casteel, n/k/a Tayr Kilaab al Ghashiyah, filed a petition for review and a request to proceed without prepayment of the \$195 filing fee. On March 26, 2012, this court granted petitioner-petitioner's request to proceed without prepayment of the filing fee and stated that he "has authorized in writing the agency having custody of the prisoner's trust fund account to forward payments from the prisoner's account to the clerk of this court each time the amount in the account exceeds \$10 until the fee is paid in full." On April 23, 2012, this court denied petitioner-petitioner's petition for review. On December 4, 2013, petitioner-petitioner filed a letter requesting that this court "correct and straight[en] out with the prison business office the accounting of fee" in this matter as the petition for review was denied

"without cost[s]." On December 13, 2013, this court took no action on the December 4, 2013 letter and advised petitioner-petitioner that he was not entitled to have the filing fee returned to him.

On January 20, 2021, petitioner-petitioner filed a motion entitled "Motion to Recall the Mandate," in which he asks "the court to issue an order to discharge the debts in filing fees and bail bond and to order clerk office to return the sum of \$131.00 sum-certain to the undersigned."

IT IS ORDERED that the court will take no action on the January 20, 2021 motion. As stated in this court's December 13, 2013 order, the filing fee in this matter is not refundable.
