On January 26, 2021, defendant-appellant, Jason J. Hyatt, pro se, filed a motion entitled "Petitioner's Motion for Time Extension and Renewed Motion for Counsel," in which he requests a further extension of time to file a statement in support of his petition to review the court of appeals' decision of June 25, 2020, and the appointment of counsel to represent him in this court. The court notes that it has previously granted defendant-appellant multiple extensions of time to file his statement in support of his petition for review and has denied his motion for the appointment of counsel. See orders issued August 11, 2020, September 28, 2020, and November 30, 2020. The court's most recent order, issued on December 14, 2020, restated the deadline for filing defendant-appellant's statement in support of the petition for review, which remained January 29, 2021. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that the motion for an extension of time is granted. Defendant-appellant shall file his statement in support of the petition for review on or before April 7, 2021. Defendant-

appellant is warned that this is the last extension of time he will be granted to file his statement in support. The court has extended the deadline for defendant-appellant to complete his petition for review by more than eight months. If the statement in support is not filed by April 7, 2021, this matter will be summarily dismissed; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the motion for the appointment of counsel is denied.
