You are hereby notified that the Court, by its Clerk and Commissioners, has entered the following order:

No. 2018AP2157-CR State v. Johnson L.C. #2014CF4176

On February 2, 2021, this court construed the "Motion for Request and/or Extension/Enlargement of Time" filed by defendant-appellant, Dewhite Dante Johnson, pro se, as a timely but nonconforming petition for review and informed Mr. Johnson that a statement in support of the petition, conforming to the requirements of Wis. Stat. §§ 809.62(2) and (4) must be filed with the clerk of this court by March 4, 2021 or the petition will be summarily dismissed.

By letter filed March 2, 2021, Mr. Johnson expresses some confusion about what the statement in support of the petition for review should contain and requests to extend the deadline for filing his statement in support to April 8, 2021. Mr. Johnson is advised that § 809.62(2) provides that a petition for review must contain: (a) a statement of the issues presented for review, the method or manner of raising the issues in the court of appeals and how the court of appeals

decided the issues; (b) a table of contents; (c) a concise statement of the criteria relied upon to support the petition, or in the absence of any of the criteria, a concise statement of other substantial and compelling reasons for review; (d) a statement of the case containing a description of the nature of the case, the procedural status of the case leading up to review, the dispositions in the trial court and court of appeals, and a statement of those facts not included in the opinion of the court of appeals relevant to the issues presented for review with appropriate references to the record; (e) an argument amplifying the reasons relied on to support the petition, arranged in the order of the statement of issues presented; and (f) an appendix containing the decisions and opinion of the court of appeals and any decision of the circuit court and other portions of the record necessary for an understanding of the petition. In drafting his statement in support, Mr. Johnson should try, to the best of his ability, to follow the requirements set forth above. A copy of the guide to filing a petition for review has been included with Mr. Johnson's copy of this order.

IT IS ORDERED that Mr. Johnson's motion for an extension of time to file his statement in support of the petition for review is granted. Mr. Johnson shall file his statement in support of the petition for review on or before April 8, 2021.
