The Appellant, Kenneth Risch, comes before this Court and moves the Court to grant a 60 day time extension, pursuant to 809.14 and 809.62 as follows:

Under the terms of his supervision, Risch has extremely limited access to computers, internet and publication ability, also a recent supervision rule change completely terminated all internet and computer access with a complete refusal to assist at all knowing fully that for Risch's legal needs access to such is a necessity. For him to procure the requisite legal materials is cost prohibitive.

Covid 19 lockdowns have closed local courthouses thus denying access to their law libraries.

Risch cannot utilize libraries due to his conviction status.

These circumstances have caused an extreme hardship for Risch thus making it impossible to timely file the Petition For Review with this Court.

All of his current research, notes, and other related material is on a flash drive only accessible by computer and he does not possess or have access to any other method to type any documents either.

In closing, Risch prays this Court grant this motion. He strongly feels there is a high degree of merit in his appeal that the Court of Appeals overlooked.

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The C.O.A. did not apply the applicable governing case law correctly, ignored important testimony and conflated issues improperly.

Risch believes his appeal the requirements under 809.62(1r)(a), (k)2, and 3.(d).
