

UNOPPOSED MOTION TO ENLARGE TIME FOR FILING BRIEF

Ryan H. Mulhern, defendant-appellant in the above-entitled case, by the undersigned appellate counsel, moves this Court, pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ (Rules) 809.82(2) and 809.14 for an order extending the time in which to file his responsive brief for seven days, for the following reasons:
