ORDER

1. **Hearing Date, Time and Location:** This matter is scheduled for hearing on Tuesday, May 11, 2021 commencing at 10:00 a.m. The hearing, by consent of the parties, will be held at the Juneau County Justice Center, 200 Oak Street, Mauston, WI 53948.
2. **Continued Scheduling Conference:** The Continued Telephone Scheduling Conference is adjourned to Tuesday, April 13, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. Attorney Hendrix is directed to place the call.
3. **Anticipated Length of Hearing:** It is anticipated that the hearing will be completed in one day.
4. **Court Reporter:** OLR shall arrange for a court reporter for the hearing.
5. **Amendments to Pleadings:** No amendments to pleadings are contemplated.
6. **Witness Lists, Exhibits, Documents including Stipulations of Fact:** Witness lists, exhibits and other documents including Stipulations of Fact shall be filed with the Supreme Court, exchanged and provided to the Referee no later than April 12, 2021.
 - a. **Exhibits:** Each party shall file with the referee a complete marked copy of all exhibits to be used at the hearing.
 - b. Exhibits shall be marked and each party shall place their exhibits in a 3-ring binder in chronological order and supply both the referee and opposing counsel with a binder containing all copies of exhibits.
 - i. OLR to start with Exhibit 100
 - ii. Respondent to start with Exhibit 500
 - iii. In the alternative the parties may agree upon a joint exhibit presentation. The agreed upon exhibits shall be marked starting with Exhibit 1 and placed in a three ring binder.

7. **Discovery:** Discovery has been completed.

8. **Pre-hearing motions:**

- a. All prehearing motions shall be in writing.
- b. Upon receipt of any pre hearing motions, the referee shall set a telephone motion hearing, prior to the May 11, 2021 hearing date, at which time the motion will be heard. The motion will be on the record and OLR shall arrange for a court reporter for the telephone hearing.

9. **Trial Briefs:** The filing of trial briefs, either pre or post hearing, shall be discussed at the April 13, 2021 Continued Telephone Scheduling Conference

10. **Referee's Recommendation.** The parties are reminded that the Referee will make a recommendation based upon the record and that he will not be aware of prior discipline, other pending matters, or other evidence, unless presented as part of this case. The parties are directed to verbally highlight, during the hearing, relevant portions of lengthy exhibits or depositions which they wish to bring to the attention of the Referee

11. **Filing of Documents:** All original documents and correspondence shall be filed with the Clerk of the Wisconsin Supreme Court. Copies shall be provided to the Referee and to opposing counsel. Also, each party shall provide the Referee and opposing counsel with copies by way of e-mail (with attachments) followed by copies by way of US Mail.


