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You are hereby notified that the Court, by its Clerk and Commissioners, has entered the following order:

No. 2020AP1110-CRNM State v. Dantonio L.C.#2018CF1611

By order dated March 8, 2021, this court construed the letter, signed February 28, 2021, and filed by defendant-appellant, Michelle A. Dantonio, as a timely but nonconforming petition to review the court of appeals' decision of February 3, 2021, and informed defendant-appellant that unless a statement in support of the petition conforming with the requirements of Wis. Stat. §§ 809.62(2) and (4) was filed by April 7, 2021, the petition for review would be summarily dismissed. By letter dated April 4, 2021, defendant-appellant advised this court that she had made substantial progress on, but had not yet completed, a statement in support of the timely but nonconforming petition for review.

IT IS ORDERED that a statement in support of the petition, conforming to the requirements of Wis. Stat. §§ 809.62(2) and (4), must be filed with the clerk of this court by April 30, 2021.

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This is the last time extension in this matter; no more will be granted. If the statement in support is not filed by that time, this petition will be summarily dismissed.
