No. 2018AP872-CRNM State v. Hyatt L.C. #2016CF395

By order dated August 11, 2020, this court construed the motion of defendant-appellant, Jason J. Hyatt, pro se, for appointment of counsel to assist in his filing of a petition for review as a timely but nonconforming petition for review and informed defendant-appellant that unless a statement in support of the petition conforming with the requirements of Wis. Stat. §§ 809.62(2) and (4) was filed by October 12, 2020, the petition for review would be summarily dismissed. By order dated September 28, 2020, this court extended the deadline for filing the statement in support to November 11, 2020. By order dated November 30, 2020, this court extended the deadline for filing the statement in support to January 29, 2021. By order dated February 25, 2021, this court extended the deadline for filing the statement in support to April 7, 2021, and advised defendant-appellant that no further extensions would be granted and that his petition for review would be summarily dismissed if he failed to file his statement in support by April 7, 2021. No statement in support of the petition has been filed. The court finds that defendant-appellant's failure to file his
