You are hereby notified that the Court, by its Clerk and Commissioners, has entered the following order:

No. 2019AP664-CRState v. Johnson L.C.#2017CF56

By order dated April 8, 2021, this court extended the deadline for filing the response brief of the appellant, T.A.J., to April 22, 2021, and granted T.A.J.'s motion to seal the motion for extension. On April 15, 2021, T.A.J. filed a second motion to extend the time for filing the response brief, together with a motion to file the second extension motion under seal. The extension motion sets forth the reasons for the extension request which are not relevant to the merits of the case.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that motion of the Wisconsin Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers for leave to file an amicus brief is granted. Twenty-two copies of the brief shall be filed no later than the due date for the reply brief of the defendant-respondent-petitioner, Alan S. Johnson.
