On April 23, 2021, respondent-appellant, Anthony R. Salin, pro se, filed, by way of facsimile, a petition for review pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 808.10.

A petition for review must: (1) comply with Wis. Stat. §§ (Rules) 809.62 and 809.81; (2) be accompanied by the required \$195 filing fee, unless waived; and (3) be physically filed with the clerk of the supreme court within 30 days of the date of the court of appeals' decision unless a timely motion for reconsideration is filed in the court of appeals. See Wis. Stat. § 808.10 and § (Rule) 809.80. The subject of a petition for review must be the final decision of the court of appeals. In Interest of A.R., 85 Wis. 2d 444, 270 N.W.2d 581 (1978).

The court notes that the court of appeals has not rendered a final decision in either of the appellate cases referenced by Mr. Salin in his petition for review. The court further notes that the filing of a petition for review via facsimile is not permitted. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED the petition for review is dismissed.
