“EMERGENCY MOTION FOR A STAY OF SENTENCES[;] This is new evidence and new arguments[;] PETITION FOR SUPERVISORY WRIT.” At the conclusion of the email, Mr. Puchner wrote: “Electronically signed[,] John Puchner.” The email attached PDFs of various documents.

On May 28, 2021, at 3:32 PM, Mr. Puchner sent the clerk of court's office, along with various other individuals, an email with the subject line: "SUPREME COURT MUS[T] ORDER TODAY. IT ALSO VIOLATES THE ORDER—I HAVE NOT BEEN GIVEN PROPER NOTICE." In the body of the email, Mr. Puchner wrote that he sought emergency injunctive relief based on certain alleged errors by the circuit court. At the conclusion of the email, Mr. Puchner wrote: "Electronically signed by John Puchner."

IT IS ORDERED that the court will take no action on these submissions. Documents in the supreme court must be filed on paper along with the required number of copies; signed with a handwritten signature; and served via paper copy by traditional methods. See Wis. Stat. § 802.05(1); § (Rule) 809.19 (8)(a); 809.62(4); 809.80(1), (2), (3), and (4); and 809.81(2). Mr. Puchner's submissions satisfy none of these requirements, nor has Mr. Puchner paid the filing fee or sought a fee waiver. Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.25(2); 814.29.
