**ORDER COMPELLING DISCOVERY
(Following Hearing on OLR Motion To Compel Discovery)**

A telephonic hearing was held on December 3, 2020 on the motion of OLR to Compel Discovery. The motion was dated October 28, 2020. The appearances at the hearing were:

Attorney Jonathan Hendrix on behalf of OLR

Attorney Eric L. Crandall on his own behalf.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. Written discovery requests were sent to Attorney Crandall on July 23, 2020.
2. The responses to the requests were due within 30 days.
3. The requested discovery was not responded to within the 30 days.


4. OLR followed up on the discovery requests by both email and written correspondence.
5. Attorney Crandall did not respond to those requests.
6. Attorney Crandall acknowledges that he has not responded to the written discovery requests even though he previously indicated in a telephone conference on November 17, 2020, that he would do so prior to the motion hearing.

1. The Motion to Compel Discovery is granted.
2. The discovery shall be provided no later than December 18, 2020.


