PDF s of various documents, including a document titled, “Petition For Supervisory Writ—This Will Not Cite Puchner. This Is Different.” Although Mr. Puchner lists the “Suprem[e] Court” in the caption of the document, he states that he “hereby move[s] the Court of Appeals District 2 for a supervisory writ in the above captioned case.” In his petition, Mr. Puchner asks this court to stay certain jail sentences imposed by the circuit court. At the conclusion of the document, Mr. Puchner writes: “Signed electronically by John Puchner M.D. I am in jail.”

IT IS ORDERED that the petition is dismissed. Neither the appellate rules nor this court’s orders regarding appellate court operations during the COVID-19 pandemic allow for a supervisory writ proceeding to be commenced here in this manner. See Wis. Stat. §§ 802.05(1); (Rule) 809.51; 809.71; 809.80(1), (2), (3); 809.81(2). Mr. Puchner has also failed to pay the filing fee or seek a fee waiver. Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.25(2); 814.29.
