No. 2020AP1911-OA School Choice Wisconsin Action v. Bowersox

On November 30, 2020, the Wisconsin Institute of Law and Liberty (WILL) filed, on behalf of its clients School Choice Wisconsin Action, et al., an "Emergency Motion For Clarification And/Or For Leave To Amend The Emergency Petition For An Original Action And/Or To Hold Respondents In Contempt Of Court And For Remedial Sanctions."
