The court having considered the motion of petitioner-appellant, Thaddeus M. Lietz, pro se, to extend the time in which to file a petition to review the court of appeals' decision of May 11, 2021, which the court of appeals declined to reconsider by order dated May 28, 2021, and the court noting that the motion, as well as the envelope in which it was placed, indicate that they were mailed through the prison mail system on or before June 28, 2021;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED the motion itself shall be deemed to be a timely but nonconforming petition for review. See State ex rel. Nichols v. Litscher, 2001 WI 119, 247 Wis. 2d 1013, 635 N.W.2d 292. However, a statement in support of the petition, conforming to the requirements of Wis. Stat. §§ 809.62(2) and (4), must be filed with the clerk of this court by August 6, 2021. If the statement is not filed by that time, this petition will be summarily dismissed.
