Pursuant to this court's June 15, 2021 order entitled "In re Interim Court Rule Governing Electronic Filing in the Supreme Court," (Nos. 19-02A and 20-07A) and the "Wisconsin Supreme Court Electronic Filing Pilot Project: Revised Interim Rule Beginning July 1, 2021" adopted by the June 15, 2021 order, petitions for review (and appendices) in cases that are not part of the Supreme Court eFiling pilot project must be filed as paper originals (with the required number of copies) that are physically delivered to the Clerk of the Supreme Court within the 30-day period required by Wis.
