The defendant-appellant-petitioner, Jose H. Reynosa, by his counsel, Attorney Gary Grass, filed a timely petition for review on May 5, 2021, along with a motion for leave to file a supplemental petition for review. Attorney Grass explained that counsel and Mr. Reynosa were evaluating their disagreement with respect to the issues and arguments to be presented to this court and further explained that Mr. Reynosa had limited access to legal research materials, such that an extension was necessary. The court granted the motion for leave to file a supplemental petition for review by June 7, 2021. On June 8, 2021, counsel for Mr. Reynosa requested a further extension, which this court granted by order dated June 22, 2021. On June 28, 2021, counsel

requested another extension. The court granted the extension request by order dated June 30, 2021, but directed that the supplemental petition be filed by July 19, 2021.

On July 22, 2021, this court received several documents from Mr. Reynosa, who is now proceeding pro se: (1) a motion for extension of time to file the supplement to the petition; (2) a motion to accept the supplemental petition/notice of appearance; and (3) Mr. Reynosa's supplemental petition for review and appendix. Defendant-appellant, Jose H. Reynosa's supplemental petition was timely filed under Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.80(3)(e). With respect to Mr. Reynosa's request for leave to make clarifications to the supplemental petition, the court will advise the parties if additional briefing or clarification is necessary. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the motion for an extension of time to file the supplemental petition is dismissed as moot; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the supplemental petition for review filed July 22, 2021 by defendant-appellant-petitioner, Jose H. Reynosa, pro se, is accepted as filed;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the motion to accept the supplemental petition and the notice of appearance are accepted for filing, the court duly noting that Mr. Reynosa will proceed pro se in this matter.
