Plaintiff-appellant-petitioner Aquilla Jessie's petition for review under Wis. Stat. § 808.10 is pending before this court. The petition asks this court to review the court of appeals' decision of April 29, 2021.

We note that on August 19, 2021, the circuit court entered an order in the underlying circuit court proceedings. Although that order states that the appellate record in this matter "shall be supplemented to include" an August 18, 2021 order of the circuit court, we note that the circuit court may order the supplementation of the record only up until the point of its transmittal, see
