Office of Lawyer Regulation v. Danny Garcia

The Office of Lawyer Regulation (OLR) has filed a motion asking this court to issue an order granting the OLR permission to use the procedure set forth in SCR 22.13(1)¹ to effectuate service of the OLR Director's notice to Attorney Danny Garcia that his to license to practice law in Wisconsin will be automatically suspended pursuant to SCR 22.03(4)(a) unless Attorney Garcia timely complies with SCR 22.03(4)(a)1., 2., or 3. (hereafter, the "notice"). Supreme Court Rule 22.03(4)(a) requires that the notice be served by personal service. In its motion, the OLR explains that, despite repeated attempts by a process server, the OLR has been unable to obtain personal service of the notice on Attorney Garcia.

IT IS ORDERED that, given the particular circumstances of this case, the OLR may use the procedure set forth in SCR 22.13(1) to effectuate service of the notice under SCR 22.03(4)(a) on Attorney Garcia. That is, the OLR may accomplish service of the notice on Attorney Garcia

¹ Supreme Court Rule 22.13(1) provides:

The complaint and order to answer shall be served upon the respondent in the same manner as a summons under section 801.11(1) of the statutes. If, with reasonable diligence, the respondent cannot be served under section 801.11(1)(a) or (b) of the statutes, service may be made by sending by certified mail an authenticated copy of the complaint and order to answer to the most recent address furnished by the respondent to the state bar.
