By order of June 21, 2021, this court dismissed the petition for noncompliance with this court's rules, as well as Mr. Puchner's failure to pay the filing fee or seek a fee waiver. See Wis. Stat. §§ 802.05(1); (Rule) 809.51; 809.71; 809.80(1), (2), (3); 809.81(2); see also § (Rule) 809.25(2); 814.29.

On September 14, 2021, Mr. Puchner sent the clerk of court's office, along with various other individuals, an email attaching PDFs of two documents: (1) a document almost identical to the document he emailed the clerk's office in June 2021 titled "Petition For Supervisory Writ— This Will Not Cite Puchner. This Is Different."; and (2) what appears to be an excerpt from SCR Chapter 60.
