On September 21, 2021, this court granted the petition for review filed by the other party-appellant-petitioner, Michael Huebsch; consolidated the appeals; and established a briefing schedule. That order did not address the filing of a statement on transcript or the transmittal of the record to this court. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the court reporter shall file any additional transcript requested within eight calendar days of the date of this order;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the other party-appellant-petitioner need not file a docketing statement;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the clerk of the circuit court shall transmit the record on or before October 15, 2021. The clerk of the circuit court shall not be required to make the record available for inspection prior to transmittal, but is encouraged to do so if possible;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if any party believes the record needs to be corrected or supplemented, that party shall file a motion with this court seeking correction or supplementation of the record on or before October 20, 2021;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the briefing schedule established in this court's September 21, 2021 order is modified as follows: the other party-appellant-petitioner must file a brief in this court on or before October 28, 2021; that within 20 days of filing the petitioners-respondents, County of Dane, County of Iowa, Town of Wyoming, and Village of Montfort; respondent-respondent-respondent, Public Service Commission of Wisconsin; intervenor-petitioner-respondent, Driftless Area Land Conservancy; and intervenors-respondents, Wisconsin Wildlife Federation, Chris Klopp, LeRoy Belken, Gloria Belken, S.O.U.L. Wisconsin, Clean Energy Organizations, Dairyland Power Cooperative, ITC Midwest LLC, American Transmission Company, LLC, Midcontinent Independent System Operator Inc., ATC, LLC and WEC Energy Group, Inc. must file either a brief or a statement that no brief will be filed; and that if a brief is filed by any of these parties, within 10 days of filing of the last response brief the other party-appellant-petitioner must file either a reply brief or a statement that no reply brief will be filed.
