Office of Lawyer Regulation v. Michele A. Tjader

On June 11, 2019, the court temporarily suspended Attorney Michele A. Tjader's license to practice law in Wisconsin following her failure to respond to an order from this court, directing Attorney Tjader to show cause why the court should not temporarily suspend her license to practice law in Wisconsin for failure to comply with the terms of this court's October 16, 2018 decision. In re Disciplinary Proceedings Against Tjader, 2018 WI 96, 384 Wis. 2d 91, 918 N.W. 2d 418 (Abrahamson and A.W. Bradley, J.J., dissent; Dallet, J., did not participate). In that decision, we mandated that, consistent with the terms of a stipulation executed by the parties, Attorney Tjader "shall submit any fee dispute, if pursued by any of the three grievants noted in the decision, to binding fee arbitration before the State Bar of Wisconsin Fee Arbitration Program and shall comply with any arbitration award." Id., ¶20.

On August 30, 2021, this court received a letter from Lynette Haman, a grievant, in the underlying disciplinary proceeding, advising the court that she filed an application with the State Bar of Wisconsin requesting binding arbitration in November 2018, and that, as of the date of her letter, Attorney Tjader had not responded to her request and that Ms. Haman has received no information from the State Bar of Wisconsin Fee Arbitration Program regarding the status of her request to arbitrate.
