On December 6, 2021, a no-merit petition for review and appendix pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 808.10 and 809.32(4), which seeks review of the court of appeals' decision of November 4, 2021, was timely filed on behalf of respondent-appellant-petitioner, B.J. The petition was signed by counsel for B.J., but it was not personally signed by B.J., as required by Wis. Stat. § 809.107(6)(f). A supplemental petition pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 809.32(4)(a) & (b) was not filed by B.J., and a motion for an extension of time for the respondent-appellant-petitioner to file a supplemental petition in support of review was not received. IT IS ORDERED that, on or before December 30, 2021, counsel for respondent-appellant-petitioner shall (1) obtain B.J.'s signature on the petition for review; (2) file the petition for review with B.J.'s original signature, which document shall then be placed in the court's confidential file in this matter; (3) file ten copies of the petition for review, with B.J.'s signature redacted; (4) file an electronic version of the petition for review, with B.J.'s signature redacted; and (5) serve one copy of the petition for review, with B.J.'s signature redacted, on opposing counsel. Failure to comply with these directives may result in the dismissal of the no-merit petition for review. See Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.83; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that respondent-appellant-petitioner, B.J., shall have until December 30, 2021, to file a supplemental petition in support of review satisfying the requirements of Wis. Stat. § 809.62(2)(a), (b), (c), and (e), and also satisfying the signature requirement of Wis. Stat. § 809.107(6)(f). If the supplemental petition is not filed by that time, this court will dispose of this matter based solely on the documents that have been filed.
