Bikowski v. Pro Seamless of Wisconsin, Inc., L.C. #2018CV209

The court is in receipt of a petition for review filed on behalf of plaintiff-petitioner Nathan Bikowski by Attorney Shawn B. Reed, who was admitted pro hac vice in the circuit court proceedings. The Wisconsin-licensed counsel for Mr. Bikowski is Attorney Raymond J. Peterson.

The petition for review lacks handwritten signatures from both Attorneys Reed and Peterson. See "In re Interim Court Rule Governing Electronic Filing in the Supreme Court," S. Ct. Order 19-02A and 20-07A, 2021 WI 62 (issued June 15, 2021, eff. July 1, 2021), Revised Interim Rule at 6 ("Handwritten signatures must be used to sign paper documents. See former § 802.05(1)."); see also Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.85(2)(a) (requiring an attorney admitted pro hac vice to obtain the signature of Wisconsin counsel on every document filed in court).

Wisconsin Stat. § 802.05(1) provides: "An unsigned paper shall be stricken unless omission of the signature is corrected promptly after being called to the attention of the attorney

or party." See also § (Rule) 809.84 (stating that appeals are governed by the rules of civil procedure unless the appellate rules or the circumstances of the appeal require a different result).

By this order, Attorneys Reed and Peterson are hereby notified that their handwritten signatures are required on the petition for review.

IT IS ORDERED that Attorney Shawn B. Reed and Attorney Raymond J. Peterson shall, within fourteen calendar days of the date of this order: (1) file the petition for review with their original signatures; (2) file an electronic version of the petition for review bearing their signatures; and (3) serve one copy of the petition for review bearing their signatures on opposing counsel. Failure to comply with these directives may result in the dismissal of the petition for review. See Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.83.
