The court having construed the letter of plaintiff-appellant, Lamont Donnell Sholar, as a motion to extend the time in which to file a petition to review the court of appeals' opinion of November 16, 2021;

IT IS ORDERED that the motion is denied. The 30-day period in which to file a petition for review may not be enlarged. First Wisconsin National Bank of Madison v. Nicholaou, 87 Wis. 2d 360, 274 N.W.2d 704 (1979). In addition, the motion may not be construed as a timely but nonconforming petition for review because more than 30 days have passed from the issuance of the court of appeals' decision of November 16, 2021. Petitions for review must be physically filed with the clerk of the supreme court within 30 days of the date of the court of appeals' decision
