Nelson v. Edgerton Hospital and Health Services, Inc.

The court has construed the December 17, 2021 letter filed on behalf of plaintiff-appellant, John Nelson, by his attorney, Paul Benson, as a motion for an extension of time to file a petition for review of the court of appeals' October 28, 2021 decision, which the court of appeals declined to reconsider by order dated December 7, 2021.

IT IS ORDERED that the motion is denied. The 30-day period in which to file a petition for review may not be enlarged. First Wisconsin National Bank of Madison v. Nicholaou, 87 Wis. 2d 360, 274 N.W.2d 704 (1979);

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IT IS FURTHER ORDERED the motion itself shall be deemed to be a timely petition for review. However, a statement in support of the petition, conforming to the requirements of Wis. Stat. §§ 809.62(2) and (4), must be filed with the clerk of this court by January 27, 2022. If the statement is not filed by that time, this petition will be summarily dismissed. No further time extensions will be granted.
