Dykman v. Board of Regents, L.C. #2019CV2237

On January 10, 2022, Benjamin M. Dykman, pro se, filed a motion to extend the time in which to file a petition to review the court of appeals' decision of November 4, 2021, which the court of appeals declined to reconsider by order of December 1, 2021.

IT IS ORDERED that the motion is dismissed. The 30-day period in which to file a petition for review may not be enlarged. See First Wisconsin National Bank of Madison v. Nicholaou, 87 Wis. 2d 360, 274 N.W.2d 704 (1979). Moreover, this motion cannot be construed as a timely but non-complying petition for review because it was not filed within 30 days of the date that the court of appeals denied Mr. Dykman's motion for reconsideration. See Wis. Stat. § 808.10 and § (Rule) 809.62(1m). Accordingly, this court has no jurisdiction in this matter. See Nicholaou, 87 Wis. 2d 360.
