No. 2021AP370-CRNM State v. Joshua L. Vinson, Sr., L.C. #2018CF92

By order of November 8, 2021, the court deemed a pro se motion filed by defendant-appellant-petitioner, Joshua L. Vinson, Sr., to be a timely but nonconforming petition for review of the court of appeals' October 27, 2021 decision. The order required Mr. Vinson to file a statement in support of the petition, conforming to the requirements of Wis. Stat. §§ 809.62(2) and (4), by December 28, 2021. The order warned Mr. Vinson that if he did not file the statement by that time, the court would summarily dismiss his petition.

Mr. Vinson filed nothing by the December 28, 2021 deadline. About two weeks after that deadline, in a motion dated January 10, 2022, and received by the clerk of this court on January 13, 2022, Mr. Vinson asked for an extension of time.
