The court having considered the January 21, 2022 motion of defendant-appellant, Austin F. Jahnke, pro se, to extend the time in which to file a petition for review of the court of appeals' November 22, 2021 decision;

IT IS ORDERED that the motion is denied. The 30-day period in which to file a petition for review may not be enlarged. First Wisconsin National Bank of Madison v. Nicholaou, 87 Wis. 2d 360, 274 N.W.2d 704 (1979);

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the motion itself shall be deemed to be a timely but non-conforming petition for review. However a statement in support of the petition, conforming to the requirements of Wis. Stat. §§ 809.62(2) and (4), must be filed with the clerk of this court by February 21, 2022. If the statement in support if not filed by that time, this petition will be summarily dismissed.
