The court having considered the emergency motion to vacate stay and emergency petition to bypass the court of appeals submitted on behalf of plaintiffs-respondents-petitioners, Richard Teigen and Richard Thom;

IT IS ORDERED the respondents are each directed to file a response to the emergency motion to vacate stay and emergency petition to bypass no later than 5:00 p.m. on January 27, 2022;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that no later than 5:00 p.m. on January 27, 2022, all parties are directed to file a letter not to exceed five pages in length, setting forth as to each of the 2022 statewide elections: (1) the earliest date by which each county clerk may deliver ballots to all the municipal clerks in his or her county, and the date by which each county clerk must deliver ballots to all the municipal

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that we direct the parties to comply with the court of appeals' January 25, 2022 order directing them to file letters in the court of appeals addressing scheduling issues; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all filings in this matter shall be filed as an attachment in .pdf format to an email addressed to clerk@wicourts.gov. See Wis. Stat. §§ 809.70, 809.80 and 809.81.
