Motion to remove Judges for Appellate Record alteration/destruction.

Enclosed is the Docket Index page 1 of the proposed Appendix and the Notice of Amended Notice of Appeal R-75 that Appellant has prepared as part of his appeal in which the record on appeal R-89 shows that record as been altered and destroyed (No Videos of hearings) causing appellant irreversible damage by the Circuit Judge Frank V. Carter, and as further compromised by the rulings of the three judges of The Wisconsin Court Appeals 2 on 2/10/22 who ignore the Amended Appeal R-75 in reliance on the original appeal, and rely on a bastard record without the Videos, and absent the Franchise Agreement critical to jurisdiction of the insurers defense. R-45. The amended complaint R-26 states there is no such agreement covering the accident on 12/29/2020. The claim is that the insurers have interfered with settlement.

Appellant's right of due process and a fair trial and amended appeal support the removal of the three appellate judges with Judge Carter, and the return of the case to the lower court to determine jurisdiction of the insurers under a franchise agreement or policy coverage as claimed under R-45 which documents they have not produced. As a matter of law plaintiff is entitled to default judgment R-53-54. There is no written decision to support the ruling of premature motion for default in reliance on hypothetical jurisdiction of the insurers under false insurance and franchise agreements. R-26.

Plaintiff-Appellant seeks just relief.
