Gladney v. La Quinta Inns & Suites, L.C. #2018CV5197

The court having construed the March 7, 2022 letter filed by plaintiff-appellant, Beverly Ann Gladney, pro se, as a motion for an extension of time to file a petition to review the court of appeals January 11, 2022 decision, which the court of appeals declined to reconsider by order dated February 3, 2022, and the court having received a response letter filed on behalf of defendant-respondent, La Quinta Inns and Suites;

IT IS ORDERED that the motion is denied. The 30-day period in which to file a petition for review may not be enlarged. First Wisconsin National Bank of Madison v. Nicholaou, 87 Wis. 2d 360, 274 N.W.2d 704 (1979);

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED the motion itself shall be deemed to be a timely petition for review. However, a statement in support of the petition, conforming to the requirements of Wis. Stat. §§ 809.62(2) and (4), must be filed with the clerk of this court (i.e. physically received in the office of the clerk) by March 21, 2022. If the statement in support is not filed by that time, this petition will be summarily dismissed. No further time extensions will be granted.
