The court granted certification in this case by order of February 16, 2022. The court now has before it the March 21, 2022 motion of the State of Wisconsin (State). The State asks this court to amend the briefing schedule set forth in its February 16, 2022 order to explicitly account for the fact that this case involves both an appeal and a cross-appeal from certain postconviction orders of the Kenosha County Circuit Court. The court notes that the State and defendant-appellant-cross-respondent Corey T. Rector (Rector) filed their opening briefs with this court on March 16 and 17, 2022, respectively. The court further notes that, according to the State, Rector has no objection to the State's motion to amend the briefing schedule consistent with the terms set forth below.

Upon the foregoing,

IT IS ORDERED that the State's motion is granted and the briefing schedule set forth in this court's February 16, 2022 order is amended to provide as follows:

Within 30 after the date of this court's February 16, 2022 order, the State and Rector shall either file their opening briefs or a statement that no brief will be filed; and within 20 days thereafter the State and Rector shall either file their responsive briefs or a statement that no brief will be filed; and within 10 days thereafter the State and Rector shall either file their reply briefs or a statement that no brief will be filed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all other terms of this court's February 16, 2022 order remain in effect.
