ORDER FOLLOWING A SCHEDULING CONFERENCE

On April 6, 2020, at 11:00 a.m., CT, a telephonic scheduling conference was held in this matter pursuant to SCR 22.15. The Office of Lawyer Regulation (OLR) appeared by Attorney Thomas J. Laitsch. Attorney John O. Ifediora (Ifediora) appeared by Attorney Stacie Rosenzweig. Based upon the discussions had during the scheduling conference:

IT IS ORDERED THAT,

An Amended Answer may be filed on Ifediora's behalf on or before April 16, 2022.

A hearing will be held in this matter on November 14 and 15, 2022, commencing each day at 9:00 a.m. at the offices of Quarles & Brady LLP, 411 East Wisconsin Avenue, Suite 2400, Milwaukee, WI 53202 (Hearing). OLR shall secure the attendance and services of a court reporter for the Hearing.

Each party shall disclose to the other the names, and contact information of any witness(es) they intend to call at the Hearing, with a summary of each witness's anticipated testimony on or before June 30, 2022. Such witness information may be supplemented based on discovery prior to August 1, 2022. All discovery shall be completed by September 30, 2022.


On or before October 21, 2022, each party shall file with the Referee, and provide to the other party, a complete copy of all exhibits they intend to introduce at the Hearing, placed in a binder in the order of intended use. OLR's exhibits shall be marked beginning with exhibit 1, Ifediora's exhibits beginning with 200. Alternatively, the parties may agree upon a joint exhibit presentation which shall be marked and placed in a binder. Any pre-hearing motions a party wishes to file shall be in writing and also be provided to the Referee and the other party on or before October 21, 2022, accompanied by a supporting brief and any other supporting material. A moving party shall arrange a three-way telephonic conference for their motion to be heard after consulting with the other party and the Referee on an acceptable date and time. OLR shall arrange for a court reporter for such hearing,

A telephonic Status Conference will be held on July 15, at 11:00 a.m. CT, the call to be initiated by one of the parties.

Each party shall file a pre-hearing brief on or before November 1, 2022 outlining what they believe to be the issues, what they intend to prove with respect to each and the legal support of their positions.

The Referee will make a recommendation based solely upon the record made at the Hearing. All original documents and correspondence shall be filed with the Supreme Court, via U.S. Mail with copies to the Referee and the other party. Copies to the Referee and the other party shall be by e-mail followed by copies via U.S. Mail.
