On March 28, 2022, attorneys for defendant-respondent-cross-appellant, Oakwood Acquisition, LLC, filed a timely petition for review of the court of appeals' decision of February 24, 2022, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 808.10. On April 5, 2022, the clerk of the court of appeals inadvertently remitted this matter to the circuit court. The matter was remitted in error. Wis. Stat. § 809.26 (“[i]f a petition for review is filed pursuant to s. 809.62, the transmittal is stayed until the supreme court rules on the petition”); State ex rel. Fuentes v. Court of Appeals, 225 Wis. 2d 446, 593 N.W.2d 48 (1999). Therefore,
