State v. Trevor L. Young L.C.#2021CF1587 & 2021CF1588

This court is in receipt of a pro se “Motion for a New Trial” and two supporting letters filed on behalf of Trevor L. Young, received May 4, May 3, and May 19, 2022, respectively. The motion bears Milwaukee County Circuit Court Case Nos. 2021CF1587 and 2021CF1588. Consolidated Court Automation Program (CCAP) records associated with these case numbers show that on April 14, 2022, a jury convicted Mr. Young of various crimes following a jury trial, at which Mr. Young was represented by counsel appointed by the Public Defender’s Office. CCAP records further show that on May 6, 2022, Mr. Young’s counsel was allowed to withdraw from representation, and the Public Defender’s Office is expected to appoint new counsel. Sentencing has not yet occurred.

Given the procedural posture described above,

IT IS ORDERED that the court will take no action on Mr. Young’s “Motion for a New Trial” and supporting letters. Mr. Young will be informed at sentencing of his right to seek postconviction relief. See Wis. Stat. § 973.18.
