The court having considered the pro se petition for writ of habeas corpus filed by petitioner, William R. Shaw;

IT IS ORDERED that the petition is dismissed. The court notes that Mr. Shaw has filed a substantially similar petition for writ of habeas corpus in the court of appeals. See Shaw v. Lucas, Case No. 2022AP805-W. Because Mr. Shaw has adequate remedies available at law, his habeas petition cannot go forward in this court. See State ex rel. Marberry v. Macht, 2006 WI 79, ¶23, 262 Wis. 2d 720, 665 N.W.2d 155 (prerequisites for habeas relief include a showing that there are no other adequate remedies available in the law).
